

Adult Education Initial Training Course: Protecting Children in the 21st Century



Instructions:

The initial (first-time) training course provided through the **Compass Abuse Prevention Services Safe Environment Training Program** replaces the Diocesan in-person *Initial Child Protection Policy Training* course.

All new volunteers, employees, religious and clergy should complete the initial course by following the instructions below.

If you have already attended our Diocesan *Initial Child Protection Policy Training*, you are REQUIRED to take the refresher course, not this Protecting Children in the 21st Century course.

- 1. Create a user profile via the right side of the screen on the training website. **Important**: Be sure to save your username and password, so you can return to the website for resources or future training programs. Use your **LEGAL NAME** (no nicknames) in your profile.
- 2. Complete the "Protecting Children in the 21st Century" course online at your convenience.

Read the instructions, review the course, and complete the rest of the steps:

- ✓ Complete the 20-question quiz.
- ✓ Review and Print the Safe Environment Contact Card.
- ✓ Certificate (review the Code of Conduct, click the checkbox to agree).
- Your certificate will be automatically emailed to the Location Coordinator of the site that you indicated in your profile. You may also print your certificate and/or save it to your computer.
