

STUDENT HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

HEALTH EXAM/ REQUIRED IMMUNIZATION	DENTAL EXAM	VISION EXAM
<p>Grades: PK – K – 6 Or entering an Illinois school for the first time (K-8)</p> <p>Completed prior to 9/15 (required components are health history, diabetic screening, lead risk assessment or testing and completed physical exam)</p> <p>EXCEPTIONS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - exempt based on religious grounds <p>REPERCUSSIONS Child will be excluded from school until proof presented.</p> <p>SCHOOL REPORTING County Health Dept. will check school records for completion</p>	<p>Grades: K – 2 – 6</p> <p>Proof presented prior to 5/15 of the school year and completed within 18 months prior to 5/15 deadline.</p> <p>EXCEPTIONS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - child enrolled in free/reduced lunch program and not covered by private or public dental insurance - child enrolled in free/reduced lunch program and is ineligible for public insurance - child enrolled in Medicaid/ All Kids, but family unable to find dentist or clinic in community able to see child who accepts these programs - exempt based on religious grounds <p>REPERCUSSIONS May hold report card until</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - proof of exam turned in - waiver form turned in - child presents exemption based on religious grounds - child presents proof of appointment that will take place within 60 days after 5/15 (must present proof of exam before attending school in subsequent year) <p>SCHOOL REPORTING Report stats to ISBE by 6/30 Must give notice of dental exam requirements to parents at least 60 days prior to 5/15 of each school year</p>	<p>K – or enrolling in an Illinois school for first time (K-8)</p> <p>Proof presented that exam took place within the previous year before 10/15 of school year.</p> <p>EXCEPTIONS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - children who show an undue burden or lack of access to physician licensed to practice med in all its branches who provides eye exams or to a licensed optometrist. - exempt based on religious grounds - child enrolled in free/reduced lunch program and ineligible for public insurance - child enrolled in public insurance but unable to find medical doctor who performs eye exams or an optometrist in the community that is able to see child and accepts public insurance - child does not have any type of medical or vision/eye care insurance coverage, and there is no low-cost vision/eye clinics in community that will see the child <p>REPERCUSSIONS May hold child’s report card until proof of exam or appointment within 60 days after 10/15 deadline</p> <p>SCHOOL REPORTING Report stats to ISBE by 6/30 Must give notice of eye exam requirement to parents</p>
